Practical Exercise 11

Objective:

1. To enable students to understand the **impact of Industrial Revolution** during the British Raj in India.

Material Required:

1. Unlined/ blank sketchbook (A3).
2. Scissor, glue.
3. Reference books, magazines.

Procedure:

1. Identify specific categories of textiles and clothing worn in England and Europe which were based on Indian exports during the Industrial Revolution.
2. Visit a museum for additional information (optional).
3. Refer to books, journals in the library and the internet to do the following:
 - i. Find articles on the impact of restrictive rules and regulations on Indian weavers during the British Raj.
 - ii. Find pictures of European garments using Indian textiles and prints.
4. Use photocopies of visuals and paste them on sheets/notebook with suitable labels indicating the product (textiles and clothing), reference name (if any) and year.
5. Submit these to the teacher. In addition make a presentation to the class.

Observation and Discussion:

1. What were the short-term and long-term repercussions of Industrial Revolution in India?
2. Are traditional textile prints and apparel designs still used by designers?
