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Singular and Plural

A **noun** that stands for **only one person, place or thing** is called as '**Singular**' noun. Eg: **star, boy, pencil, box** etc

A **noun** that stands for **more than one person, place or thing** is called as '**Plural**' noun.
Eg: **stars, boys, pencils, boxes, classes** etc

Rules of changing 'Singular' into 'Plural'

- By adding '**s**' to the singular noun .
Eg: book- books, cat- cats, flower- flowers etc
- By adding '**es**' to the nouns that end in - **ss, sh, ch, x, o**.
Eg: match- matches, bush – bushes, potato – potatoes, etc
- By adding '**s**' to a noun , if the noun ends with '**y**' and has a vowel before it .
Eg: monkey – monkeys, tray- trays, key- keys etc
- By adding '**ies**' to the nouns which end with '**y**'.
Eg; baby- babies, lady- ladies, fly- flies etc.

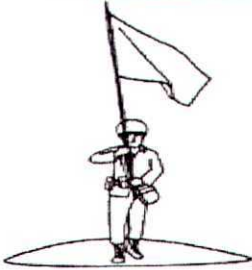
