#### **Major Passes of India**

#### JAMMU AND KASHMIR

- Karakoram Pass: This pass is located in the middle of the Karakoram hills in the Ladakh region. It is the highest pass of India. The pass is located at an elevation of 5654 meters above sea level. It connects POK and China.
- Zojila Pass: This pass connects the Kashmir Valley to Leh. It is situated in the Zanskar range of Jammu and Kashmir. Its height above sea level is 3528 meters.
- 3. **Pirpanjal Darsh:** This pass is situated in the south-west of the Kashmir Valley. This pass is at an altitude of 3490 meters above sea level in the Pirpanjal mountain range.
- 4. Banihal Pass: This pass is situated in the south-west of Jammu and Kashmir. The road from Jammu to Srinagar passes through this pass. The height of this pass is 2832 meters above sea level. Jawahar tunnel is also located on this pass.
- Burzil Pass: This pass connects Srinagar and Gilgit. Its height above sea level is 4100 meters.

#### HIMACHAL PRADESH

1. Shipkila Pass: This pass is situated in the Zanskar range of Himachal Pradesh. It

connects Shimla to Tibet. Its height above sea level is 4300 meters.

- Rohtang Pass: This pass is situated in the Pir Panjal range of Himachal Pradesh. Its height above sea level is 4630 meters. It connects Manali and Leh by road.
- Baralacha La Pass: This pass is situated in the Jaskar range of Himachal Pradesh. It connects the Mandi and Leh routes. Its height above sea level is 4850 meters.

#### UTTARAKHAND

Mana Pass: This pass is situated in the Kumaon hills of Uttarakhand.

Its height above sea level is 5545 meters. Indian pilgrims go through this pass to visit Mansarovar Lake and Kailash.

There have been a well graded Indian military road at 5610 meters west of Mana Pass. Mana Pass is also called DungriLa Pass.

Niti Pass: It is located in Kumaon, Uttarakhand. The height of this pass is 5389 meters above sea level. It connects Uttarakhand with Tibet. Pilgrims also go from here to visit Mansarovar Lake and Kailash.

Lipulekh Pass: Located in Pithoragarh, Uttarakhand, this pass connects Uttarakhand to Tibet. Its height above sea level is 5334 meters. Pilgrims go through this pass to visit Kailash Parvat and Mansarovar Lake.

#### SIKKIM

Nathula Pass: It is located in the Dongkya range in the state of Sikkim, it became more popular due to its strategic importance in the Indo-China war of 1962. From this, there is a way to go to Tibet via Darjeeling and Chumbi Valley. Its height above sea level is 4310 meters.

Jelepla Pass: Through this pass, the route to Tibet is made through Darjeeling and Chumbi valley. Trade between India and China is also done through this pass. It is situated in East Sikkim at an altitude of 4270 meters above sea level.

#### **ARUNACHAL PRADESH**

**Bomdila Pass:** This pass connects Tawang in Arunachal Pradesh and Tibet. Its height above sea level is 2217 meters.

Yangyap Pass: It is situated in the north-east of Arunachal Pradesh. The Brahmaputra river enters India through the Yangyap pass. It connects India and China on the Indo-Tibet border. Dimphu and Likhapani passes are also in Arunachal Pradesh.

#### MANIPUR

**Tuju Pass:** This pass is situated in the southeast of Manipur. Roads from Imphal to Tamu and Myanmar go through this pass.

#### **KERALA**

Pal Ghat Pass: This pass connects Kerala and Tamil Nadu. This pass is situated between Annamalai and Nilgiri hills.

#### **MAHARASHTRA**

Thal Ghat Pass: This pass is situated on the Mumbai-Nashik road.

Bhor Ghat Pass: This pass connects Mumbai to Pune and Chennai.

Both the above passes are situated in the Western Ghats ranges.

#### Major Waterfalls of India

#### **MEGHALAYA**

Nohkalikai Falls: This waterfall is located near Cherrapunji in the state of Meghalaya. It is formed due to rain water. Its height is 340 meters.

Nohsngithiang: It is also known as Seven Sister Water Falls. It is located in the East Khasi Hills district of Meghalaya. Its height is 315 meters.

Lang Shiang, Bishop, Dain-Thlen and Elephant Falls are also located in Meghalaya.

#### MADHYA PRADESH

Dhuandhar Falls: This waterfall is formed on the Narmada River in Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh. Its height is 15 meters.

**Kapil Dhara Waterfall:** This waterfall is also formed on the Narmada River. Its height is 33 meters and it is at a distance of 7 km from Amarkantak.

Chachai Falls (on the Bihad River), Dudh Dhara Falls (on the Narmada River), Sahastradhara Falls (on the Narmada River), Patalpani Falls (on the Chambal River) are also located in Madhya Pradesh.

#### **KARNATAKA**

Kunchikal Falls: It is the highest waterfall in India. Its height is 455 meters. It is situated on the Varahi river.

Shivanasamudra Water Fall: This water fall is situated on the river Kaveri. The Hydroelectric Power Station located on it is the first hydroelectric power station in Asia, which was established in 1902. The height of this waterfall is 98 meters.

Jog Water Fall: This water fall is on Sharavati river. It is also known as Jersappa Falls. Its height is 253 meters. It is also known as Gersoppa and Mahatma Gandhi Falls.

Gokak Falls (on Ghata Prabha River), Mekedatu Falls (on Kaveri River), Barkana (on Seetha River), Magod Falls (on Bedti River) and Hebbe Falls (on Bhadra River) are also located in Karnataka.

#### **RAJASTHAN**

Chuliya Water Falls: It is located on the Chambal River in Kota, Rajasthan. The height of this waterfall is 18 meters.

Bhimlat Water Fall: This water fall is situated between Bundi and Chittorgarh on Mangli river.

Gaipernath (in Kota), Padajhar Mahadev (in Bundi) are also located in Rajasthan.

#### MAHARASHTRA

Amboli Water Fall: This water fall is situated on the Hiranyakeshi river.

Thoseghar Falls: This water fall is situated on the Tarlee river in Satara city.

Kune Falls, Pandav Kada Falls is also situated between Lonavala and Khandala in Maharashtra.

#### **JHARKHAND**

**Hundru Falls:** It is formed on the Subarnarekha River. It is located in Ranchi district.

Rajrappa Falls: This waterfall is located in Ramgarh (Jharkhand). This water fall is formed at the confluence of Damodar and Bhera rivers.

Sita Falls (on the Kanchi River), Dassam Falls (on the Kachni River) are also located in Jharkhand.

#### **ODISHA**

Barehipani Falls: It is located in the Simlipal National Park in the Mayurbhanj district of Odisha. It comes in the course of the Budhbalang river. It falls from a height of 399 meters.

Duduma Falls: It is formed on the Machhkund river.

#### **KERALA**

Palaruvi Falls: It is formed on the Kallada River

in Kollam district of Kerala state. Its height is 91 meters. The literal meaning of Palaruvi is 'stream of milk'.

**Atirappilly Falls**: It has a height of 25 meters. This waterfall is a part of the Chalakudy River.

Kalakkayam Falls, Cheeyappara and Valara Falls are also located in Kerala.

#### TAMIL NADU

Pykara Falls: It is formed on the Pykara River.

Hogenakkal Falls (on the Kaveri River). Bear Shola, Thalaiyar Falls (on Manjalar River) are also located in Tamil Nadu.

#### **Major Lakes of India**

- □ The largest lake in India is Chilka Lake (Odisha). It is a salt water lake. The length of this lake is 70 km, the width is up to 30 km and the average depth is 3 m.
- Sambhar Lake is the largest inland saline water lake in India, which is the largest in Rajasthan.
- The largest fresh water lake in India is the Wular Lake in Jammu and Kashmir. Main source of water for Wular lake is river Jhelum.
- ☐ The largest artificial lake in India is the Govind Ballabh Pant Sagar, which is formed by a dam built on the Rihand River. It is located in Sonbhadra district of Uttar Pradesh.
