


Logical Venn Diagram

A Venn Diagram is a representation method for all possible relations that can exist between given group of elements in a single figure.


We generally use circles to represent any group. The questions asked from this type contain, a group of some elements (things) and also some diagrams. Here, a candidate is required to find out the diagram which classify the given group correctly or illustrates the relation between them.

Example 1 Identify the diagram that best represents the relationship among classes given below.

Mammal, Dog and sparrow






Dogs are mammal but sparrows are birds.

Soda water, Mineral water, Liquid




Sol. (d) According to the question,

Example 3 Which one of the following diagrams best depicts the relationship among Earth, Sea and Sun?




