Q1: What is a government?

Ans: The group of people, managing the affairs of a country is called a government.

Q2: Name the three main types of government.

Ans:- The three main types of government are:-

- a) Monarchy (run by a hereditary ruler with absolute power)
- b) Dictatorship (run by one person or a small group of persons)
- c) Democracy(run by the people themselves)

Q3: Which organ of the government makes laws?

Ans:- Legislature makes laws. It is also called law-making body.

Q4: What do you understand by universal adult franchise?

Ans: The right of all adults to vote according to their choice is called universal adult franchise.

Q1: At what levels do we have government in India?

Ans1: In India, we have government at the national level, state level and local self-government.

Q2: Give two reasons why representative democracy is a good form of government.

Ans2: Representative democracy is a good form of government as-
