

CHAPTER

English is an 'unphonetic' language. Owing to this, we are made to learn spellings in our childhood and regular dictations are conducted in schools.

We have to learn spellings but there are certain rules that help us remember or form the spellings easily.

Rule 1 : If 'y' comes after a consonant, we need to change 'y' into 'i' before adding 'es', 'ed' or 'er'.

This rule is applicable to 'verb', 'noun' and 'adjective'.

cry (Verb)	cried (V ₂ , V ₃)
fry (Verb)	fried (V ₂ , V ₃)
dry (Verb)	dried (V ₂ , V ₃)
dry (Adj.)	drier, driest
city (Noun)	cities (Pl. Noun)
country (Noun)	countries (Pl. Noun)
happy (Adj.)	happily (Adverb)

Exceptions:- carry, carrying, carried, marry, marrying, married

Rule 2 : If 'y' comes after a vowel 'y' is not changed into 'i'.

Boy (Noun)	Boys (Pl. Noun)
Pray (Noun)	Prayed (V ₂ , V ₃)
Grey (Adj.)	Greyer, greyest

Exceptions:-

Pay (verb)	Paid (V ₂ , V ₃)
Say (verb)	Said (V ₂ , V ₃)
Lay (verb)	Laid (V ₂ , V ₃)

Rule 3 : A famous saying is 'i' before 'e' except 'c'. This means 'i' comes before 'e' but this rule is not applicable when they come after 'c'. 'e' is not followed by i.e. 'C' is followed by (e,i) This rule is applicable only when the pronunciation of 'ie' and 'ei' is 'ee' as in jeep.

Examples:-

ie	ei
achieve	ceiling
belief	conceit
believe	receive
chief	deceit
thief	perceive
yield	receipt
grieve	conceive
field	

This rule is not applicable to science, efficient, their, beige, foreign, height, neighbour, vein, weight because here the pronunciation is not 'ee'.

Exceptions:- In the following words the rule is not applicable though the pronunciation is 'ee'.

seize, protein, surfeit, plebeian, counterfeit

Rule 4 : The verbs that end in 'ie' take 'ing' only when 'ie' changes into 'y'.

die	dying
tie	tying
lie	lying

Rule 5 : Those words that end in silent 'e' take suffix starting with a vowel only after the 'e' is removed.

Eg:	living + ing	living
	hope + ing	hoping
	move + ing/ed	moving, moved
	drive + ing/er	driving, driver
	become + ing	becoming
	Shape + ing	Shaping

But if the suffix starts with a 'consonant', the 'e' is not removed.

hope + ful	hopeful
engage + ment	engagement
awe + some	awesome
home + less	homeless

Exceptions:-

awe + ful	awful
true + ly	truly
due + ly	duly
argue + ment	argument
whole + ly	wholly
nine + th	ninth

Rule 6 : The words that end in a short vowel and a consonant take a suffix starting with a vowel only after the last consonant is doubled.

beg - ed	begged
run + ing	running
rob + er	robber
sad + er/est	sadder, saddest
fit + er/est	fitter, fittest
begin + ing	beginning
occur + ed	occurring
kidnap + er	kidnapper

Exceptions:- When a suffix starting with a consonant is added, this rule is not applicable.

bag + ^{ed} _{vowel}	bagged ('g' doubled)
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bag + ^{ful}_{consonant} bagful ('g' not doubled)
suffix

Rule 7 : When suffix 'full' is added to a word, an 'l' is removed

Eg:	skill + full	-	skillful
	hand + full	-	handful
	mouth + full	-	mouthful
	spoon + full	-	spoonful

Rule 8 : 'Q' is followed by 'u' for all words of English language.

Queue, quiz, queen, tranquil, quest, quarrel.

Many spellings of British English are different from American English. We must use spellings as per British English.

Favor, Color, Meager & fetus are wrong because the correct spellings as per British English are Favour, Colour, Meagre, & Foetus.

Some words take two 'u' together. Eg:- vacuum, continuum, residuum
