Everyone wanted to free India
from British rule, but the desire of
burning flame was sought by few
leaders - like Gandhiji, Nehru, SV Patel
who took major steps to bring India
her independence.

Baba Arde through his desire to bring welfare to downtrader sections set up leoparsy care centre. So desire is the first step to bring out difference in the world.

Difference - an attribute of betterment

Difference is what makes our present different from past which lead a progressive life. APJ Abdul Kalam missile man of India who established DRDO and led to inculcating 5 missiles for defense security of India.

Saint Gadge Baba, who himself started cleaning the road where people use to ignore the hygiene was prominent figure which brought

difference in society, whose projection can be seen in Swachha Bharat Abhiyan.

It requires a difference to break down stereotypes which project negative image in society. For such difference to happen, a society needs people who are inculcated with different values, driven by goals; a different personality to initiate the process.

What makes a person different from the world?

To be different from the world, one needs positive attitude, an optimistic view about the set goals of life.

Persistence - the constant efforts and never giving up attitude of oneself can set him to climb upstairs and made it top. Justice Chaudhri put all his efforts constantly to fight for the rights of tribal class.

And to put constant efforts one requires patience. A patient person never has struggle story because he never considered the journey to success a struggle. Edison while discovering a bulb failed thousand times. His patience made the journey successful.

One must be most open to change and acceptance of the situation

where he stands for. IAS Ira Singal, despite she accepted her condition of being differently abled and put her constant efforts became IAS. She also recruited a transgender in her office, first one to do so.

How a different person creates a ripples of difference?

A rightful means and orientation towards the sought target and their projection towards other to motivate them to join creates ripples of changes. Buddha through righteous conduct introduced Ashtangikmarga which enlightened people around the world.

Buddhist religion is still having significant and supporters in the world. Similarly Sanitri Bai Phule was educated by his husband - a constant supporter, who later herself fought for girl child education.

A person who has broad vision that encompasses society as whole, has the potential to bring a difference. A difference that not only benefits a few but a society as whole. Dr. Homi Bhabha, who propagated nuclear energy to India, did not merely sought profit by establishing his own business firm but he had vision of India as whole.

For a difference to get incubated in society, you cannot alone make it to other end. One has to take others along. Just like in any military tussle, it is not the single person who wins, it is whole team which makes through it.

✗ leader is not a person who only lays down order on the group. True leader is one who guides the group inculcates more efficient way and get its work done with the support of others.

Sometimes a difference may be accepted by few while rejected by others. One has to initiate the process of change depending on how much it will bring betterment in society, and has to look for its reverse consequences too.

For every change to happen, one must change himself at first which will create a flickering fire to make difference in society at large.
