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Analogy

Analogy means "similarity" having a similar features. There are many ways of establishing a relationship, some of the most common ones are given here.

1. Cause and Effects

- **Ex.** 'Goitre' is related to 'Iodine' as 'Anaemia' is related to-
 - (A) Vitamin

(B) Blood

(C) Iron

(D) Weakness

Sol. The above question is based on cause and effect relationship, 'Goitre' disease is caused by the deficiency of 'Iodine'. So, if 'Goitre' is related to 'Iodine' then 'Anaemia' will be related to 'Iron' as 'Anaemia' disease is caused by the deficiency of 'Iron'. Hence, our answer is (C).
