## Q.1. Why is there a need of food security in India?'

**Ans**. Food security is needed as

- (i) The poorest section of the society might be food insecure when the country faces a national disaster/calamity like earthquake, drought, flood, Tsunami, widespread failures of crops causing famines, etc.
- (ii) Due to a natural calamity, total production of food grains decreases.
- (iii) It creates a shortage of food in the affected areas.
- (iv) Due to shortage of food, the prices go up.
- (v) At the high prices, some people cannot afford to buy food.

## Q.2. How does seasonal unemployment affect the food security?

- **Ans. (i)** Seasonal unemployment is when a person is unemployed for a particular season of the year.
- (ii) Mostly this is prevalent in rural areas because of the seasonal nature of the agricultural activities.
- (iii) In urban areas, casual construction labourers have less work, especially during the rainy season.
- (iv) Seasonal hunger exists when a person is unable to get work for the entire year.
