Q.1. How were new kingdoms administered? What was the revenue system in these kingdoms?

Ans. (i) The rulers of these new kingdoms used high-sounding titles like maharajaadhiraja (overlord of kings), tribhuvana-chakravartin (Lord of the three worlds).

(ii) The producing classes—artisans, peasants and cattle keepers were forced to pay a part of their produce as rent or tax to the landlord.

(iii) Revenue was also collected from traders.

Q.2. What do Prashastis tell us about land grants?

Ans. Prashastis are details of a king composed by a learned Brahman, who helped in the administration. They tell us of feat of the king.

(i) Kings often rewarded Brahmanas by grants of lands.

(ii) These were recorded on copper plates, which were given to those who received the land.

(iii) Those who received land could collect taxes from it.
