
ICSE BIOLOGY CLASS 7 ORGANIZATION IN LIVING THINGS

HIERARCHY OF ORGANIZATION



Cell: Structural and functional unit of life Tissue: Groups of cells similar in structure that perform a specific function

Organ: Different tissues group together and coordinate functions to form an organ

Organ system: Various organs coordinate to form an organ system e.g. stomach,

intestine, liver, pancreas etc. work together to form the digestive system

Organism: All organ systems come together


to form an organism
Population: Organisms of the same species


Population: Organisms of the same species living in a particular area

Community: populations of different species coexisting with each other in a particular area Ecosystem: Interaction of biotic community with abiotic factors

Biosphere: The region of integration between lithosphere, hydrosphere and atmosphere which supports life and contains all ecosystems
