

Think of at least 10 nouns which you read in the book.


Follow these steps to create your own pictionary

- > Pencil colours


Step 1

Cut the paper into rectangle shape measuring 25inches x8 inches




Step 2

Leave the first fold as the cover page of the book. Write your story with illustrations on the other folds.




Step4



- ii. Make your family tree like the one given below.





Numbers can also be shown on abacus. For example number 344 can be represented in the following manner:




- Choose any 3-digit number and make a web on A4 size sheet by showing it in various ways as shown above.

- Click some photographs along with them and paste them on an A4 sheet as "Memorable Moments with my Grand Parents".


ACTIVITY 5- Yummy for the Tummy!!!!!







- f. Stick the plates on half a chart paper.



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
