INTERPRETATION, REPEAL AND SAVING

18.1 INTERPRETATION

On any question as to the interpretation of any provision of these Bye-laws, the decision of Chairman shall be final.

18.2 REPEAL AND SAVING

- The existing provisions regarding Affiliation regulations and any 18.2.1 notification or orders issued there under are hereby repealed by these bye-laws.
- Repeal given in clause 18.2.1shall not affect the previous operation of 18.2.2 the said regulations or any notifications or orders made, or anything done, or action taken, there under.
- Any proceeding under the existing Regulations pending at the 18.2.3 commencement of these Bye-laws shall be continued and disposed of, as far as may be, in accordance with the provisions of these Bye-laws. as if such proceedings are under these Bye-laws.
- An appeal/representation pending at the commencement of these Bye-18.2.4 laws against an order made before such commencement shall be considered and orders thereon shall be made in accordance with these Bye-laws as if such orders were made and the appeals were preferred under these Bye-laws.
- Nothing in these Bye-laws shall be construed as depriving any person to 18.2.5 whom these Bye-laws apply, of any right of appeal/representation which had accrued to him under the regulations, notifications or orders in force before the commencement of these Bye-laws.
- As from the commencement of these Bye-laws any appeal or application 18.2.6 for review against any orders made before such commencement shall be preferred to or made under these Bye-laws as if such orders were made under these bye-laws.

18.3 JURISDICTION TO FILE SUITS

- The Secretary shall be the legal person in whose name the Board may 18.3.1
- The legal jurisdiction for the suits to be filed against the Board shall be 18.3.2 the Union Territory of Delhi only.
