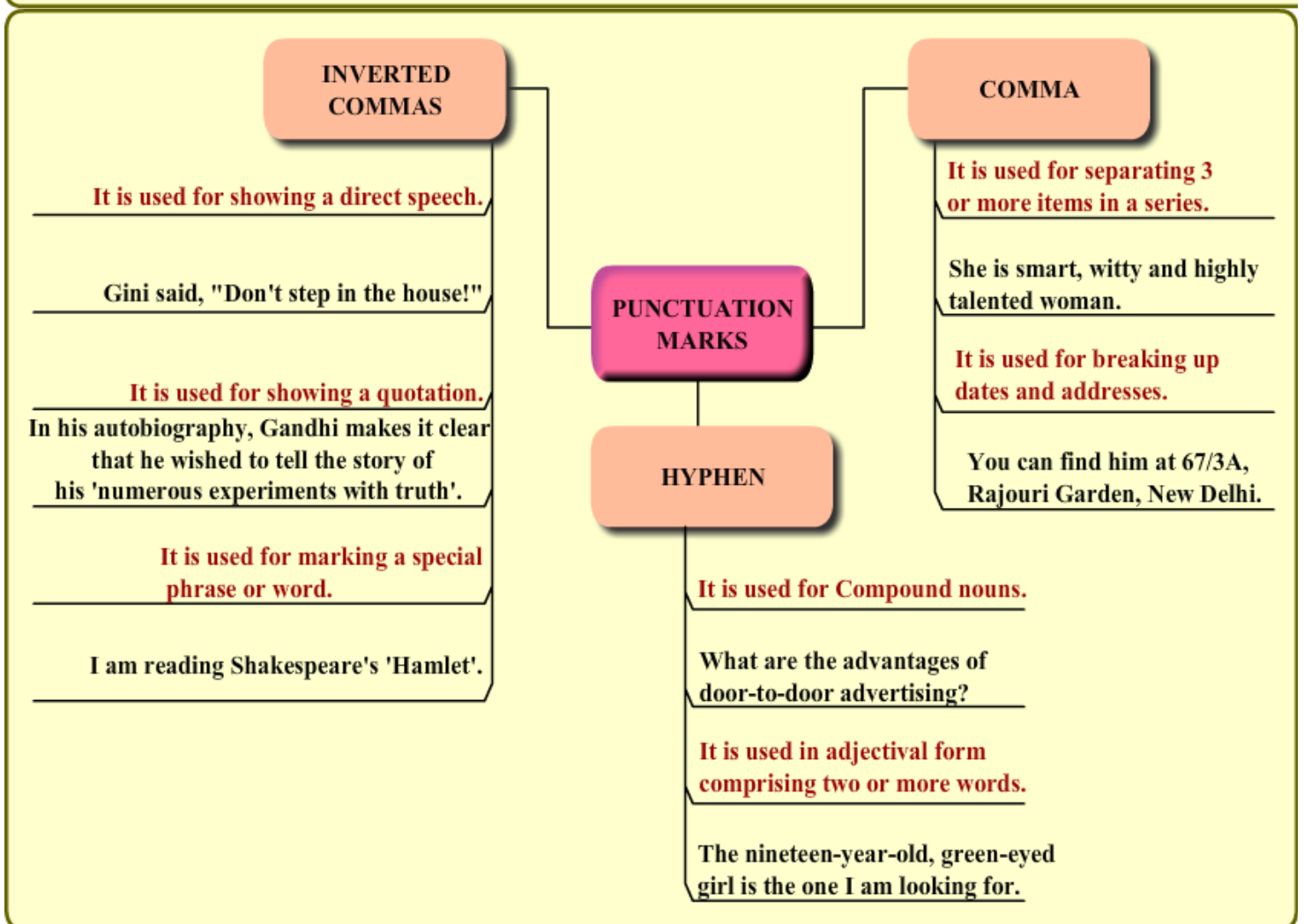
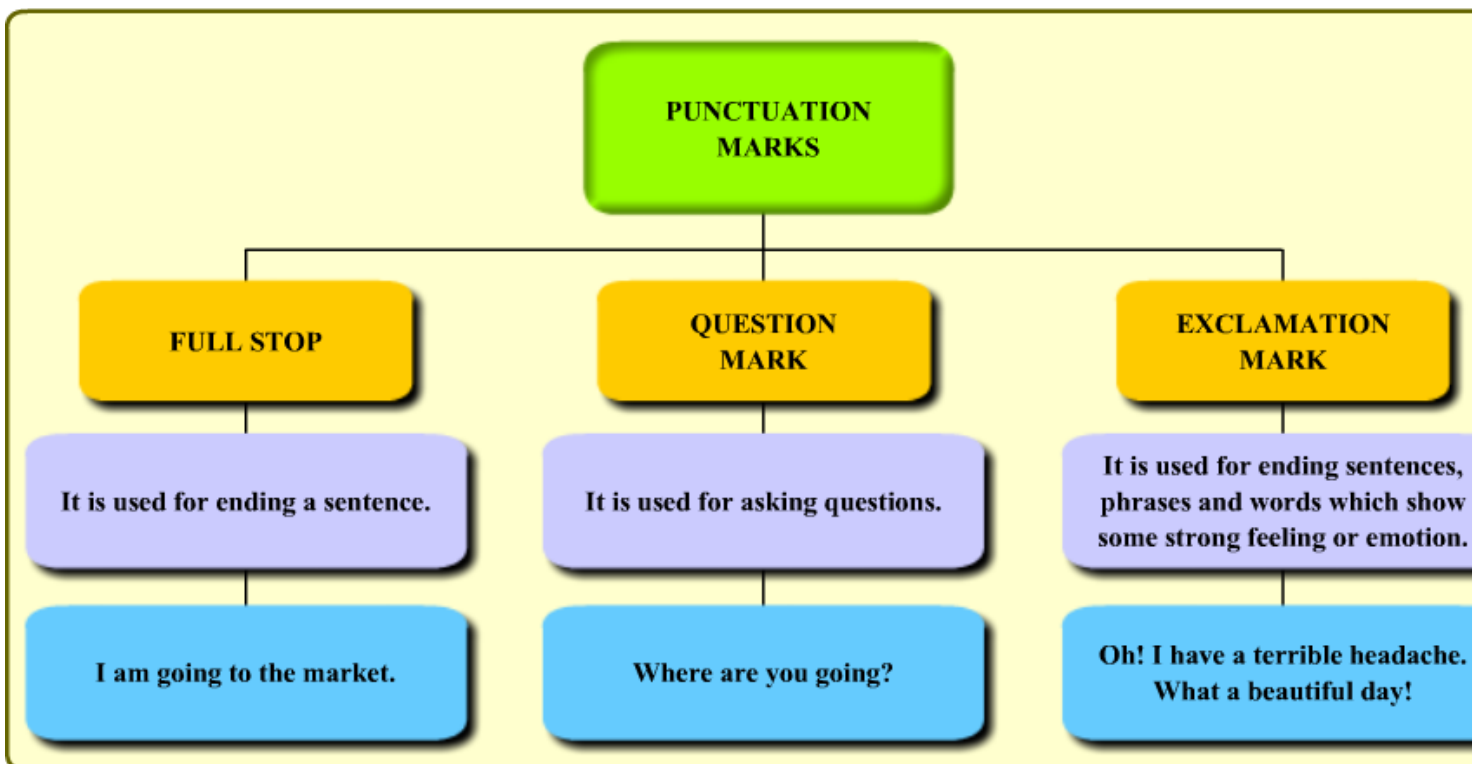


Punctuation

Plural noun

Mom! Take me to the **children's**
park.

**Plural Noun ending
with the letter 's'**

Sara is going to live in
a **girls'** hostel.
