

# Verb

A word that expresses any kind of work that is being done is called a verb.

e.g. Go, play, touch, throw etc.

- (i) Sonia is **jumping** on the roof.
- (ii) We should not **sit** in this class.
- (iii) He said that he was ill.

## Kinds of Verb

Verbs are of two kinds. They are as follow


#### 1. Main Verb

Main verb is an action that is being done by the subject. It usually comes after 'helping verb'.

- (i) We can save our country.
- (ii) She did not **cook** food in the morning.
- (iii) They are bringing water.

Helping verbs are of two kinds



## **Primary Helping Verb**

Primary helping verb comes before main verb and defines its time and nature.

- (i) We **are going** to Delhi tomorrow. are-helping verb, going- main verb
- (ii) Arun has eaten breakfast.<u>has</u>- helping verb, <u>eaten</u>- main verb

#### **Modal Verb**

Modal verb comes before main verb and shows the sense and emotion of it.

- (i) He **may** pass this year. (may shows possibility)
- (ii) Kapil will cheat you. (will shows certainity)
- (iii) They **should** run. (should shows advice)

### Modals and their Expressions

Modals	Expresses
Can	Ability, skill, power (present)
Could	Ability, skill, power (past)
May	Probability, possibility
Might	Probability and possibility (past)
Will/Shall	Certainity of a future action
Should/ought to	Advice and proposal
Must	Cardial advice
