Social stigma of early marriage hinders the career progress of most girl children. Even in this era of widespread education and liberty, 47% of girls in India get married within age of 18. Working hard, she made herself equipped, flew into outer space, created history. If a woman possesses a burning desire, no obstacle can stop her.

Perseverence is the next important factor which will test the might of a person. Even in the families who acknowledge girls' goals, there is less time given to work on goals. They are often forced to marry or find a job when they fail in first few attempts. Successful women who clear civil services examination after failures in few attempts are examples that perseverance pays off.

The above quote being the basic values needed to be successful, it demands much more from a woman in this men biased workforce world. In careers where physical power is needed, men are considered to be always apt. But is this notion true? Not anymore. Recently a woman Anshu Jamsetji created world record by climbing Mt. Everest twice in 5 days which no man has done still. Being mother of two; she has managed to achieve this feet in her late 30s. So, ~~women~~ should still be considered physically weaker.

Another commonly prevailing notion is ~~women~~ does not have required mental strength and uncompromising attitude to be a leader. Angela Merkel is proving this notion wrong. Ranked as one of the most influential leaders in the world, she takes

forward a nation with her might. When all other nations closed door to the refugees from west Asia, only Germany allowed them.

She also asked other countries to be compassionate & remained then that whole world is a family. No doubt, Mahatma Gandhi rightly said, "If man can never be equal to a woman in spirit of selfless service".

The so called 'Men's values' are not just men's values anymore. Women have all qualities to be successful. But she must realise that she has those qualities. Women have to start believing in themselves, perhaps it's the only way they can liberate themselves.

Support from the society is equally important to inculcate the confidence. What can the society do for its girls?


