
2. (b) While civil servants have the legal right to undertake post-retirement jobs, it raises key ethical issues. Comment. (150 words) 10







e.g. Mahatma Gandhi wore khadi and prosulgated swadeshi.

↳ A man is perceived to be one of integrity. [ consistent attitude in all situations]

e.g. - I.N. Sircar in election commission  
 - A.P.J. Kalam paid bill of his family's visit to Rashtrapati Bhawan.

↳ Such people tend to avoid crisis,  
of conscience and Moral Inconsistency

e.g. A policeman beating his wife at  
home, cannot arrest and Enquire

However, her husband happens to be a good administrator as indicated by that panchayat's performance on various developmental parameters as compared to other panchayats in the district. Also, her husband enjoys the support of the local people. Given the situation, answer the following:

(a) Identify the stakeholders and issues involved in this case?

(b) What options are available to you as the District Magistrate in such a scenario? Also, evaluate each option and indicate what option will you choose.



The scandal came to light when media flagged complaints of sexual abuse of inmates of the city shelter home. A nexus of police, politicians, administration and criminals have been allegedly responsible for the racket going on for the last few years. In light of this, a lot of protests have erupted across the city.

While, on one hand, media glare has meant that people are demanding swift action, you have been asked to go slow in investigating the case by top officers in your department. Elections in the state are due in a few months, so it has become a politically sensitive issue. You are also under immense political pressure from the ruling party to not take strict action and make compromises to cover up the case.







- ④ Whether all grievances have been addressed in Environment and Social Impact Assessment i.e
  - Relocation and building of houses
  - Maintaining same community bonhomie at relocated place.
  - Economic opportunities available
- ⑤ Find out if any alternative site

for construction is available at lower costs and less harassment to public.

- ⑥ Orders an Enquiry into activities of NHO under FCRA [look into its compliance]
- ⑦ Convince elderly members to convince the people about benefits
- ⑧ Involve local population in construction of project
- ⑨ Orders a New EIA in case of any discrepancy and look for correct monetary compensation for land.

The above approach is promoting goodwill approach and catering to the right to livelihood of all stakeholders

It is a consultative, democratic, and participatory way of development as envisaged by environment impact assessment.

14. Genetic editing has several applications with its potential to edit the genomes of both somatic and germ cells. This allows for the ability to not only cure genetic diseases but to edit the characteristics of future offspring. The last few years have seen the development of several efficient, more precise genetic engineering techniques.

However, with growing sophistication, various issues of bioethics have also have come to the forefront.

→ most introns (the non coding part of DNA) do not have their functions yet known.

- creation of mutation or mosaicism could alter the genetic makeup of future generation permanently.
- 3) Fiddling with Natural principles of Evolution

→ Human Evolution has taken millions of years and its alteration in short span of time can have unforeseen results.

- 4) Intercountry Equity, Justice.

→ those with advanced technologies are at advantage

- eg → Chinese scientists created a designer baby  
 → Scientists are planning to introduce gene of athletics for enhancing performance.

5) Lack of informed consent

→ In case of Embryonic gene editing, consent is impossible

6) Creation of 'Superhuman'

→ This could create injustice, discrimination and privileges in future

eg - to avoid Racial abuse, people might want gene of fair complexion.

7) Lack of mutually agreed Code of Ethics

8) Weaponisation of these techniques

to create Superior workforce, soldiers.

Ethical Framework(A) At national level

- Science and technology policy of all countries must have proper rules and guidelines for genome editing
- only Accredited labs and scientists should be allowed to carry out such activities
- Any Embryonic gene therapy should be not allowed until further research
- All options of existing Medical and Surgical treatment must be exhausted before going on to genome editing
- projects like SnaiGen, Indian genome project should focus on Research on Human gene.

(B) At international level

- A legally binding treaty encompassing fair, just and equitable use of technology.
- ↳ No developed country should be able to exploit poor/vulnerable people from developing ones in lieu of Money.
- ↳ An international task force under WHO to conduct periodic inspections of labs carrying out such research
- ↳ Any new development in this field must be in the pool of 'global knowledge pool' and democratized.
