

# Word Formation

To change a word into the other or to form a new word by joining two words, is called word formation.

## Primary Words

The word that has no prefix or suffix is called primary word. e.g. invite, height, justice, college, friend, happy, knowledge, etc.

## Compound Words

By joining two words, a compound word is formed.

e.g. grand + mother	—	grandmother
news + paper	—	newspaper
post + man	—	postman
rain + fall	—	rainfall
