

- ③ Buddhist ethics promotes non-violence, killing oneself is a violence on self.

The Constitution envisages right to death or die with dignity.

retarding person from one's  
sufferings.
- (6) It gives rise to ethical dilemma  
to doctors who may not

but are compelled by living

The recent case of a person's friend filling a case

emotional effects.

In India passive Euthanasia  
is allowed as per Aruna Shanbaug  
Judgement but ethical debate regarding  
inconclusive.

however foreign aid has also been utilized by countries with altruistic motives.

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Rabindra Nath Tagore was a polymath Indian who propounded the Theory of Universal humanism. As per Tagore's universal humanism, humanity should be the centre of our thinking and strivings. He was against any idea of Nationalism which results in the "othering" of other people.

As per Tagore, rise of fascists was the result of this othering of other nations. Universal humanism, thus defies the idea of state boundaries and calls for universal unity of human beings.

## Contemporary Relevance

- ① Instances such as vaccine nationalism can be avoided by placing humanity at the centre.
- ② Prevalence of wars such as Russia-Ukraine war can be mitigated by promoting humanism.
- ③ Refugee crisis like Rohingya have no existence or humanism. making people stateless will on Cosmopolitanism.
- ④ Putting humanity first can mitigate issues like Human Right abuse by China in Xinjiang.
- ⑤ It can help reduce growing inequalities in society. Thus spirit of universal humanism needs to be cultivated.

### Emotional Intelligence - natural

- ① Some people have innate capacity to understand others' emotions
- ② Inner calmness is a natural virtue that allows people to act in emotionally intelligent way.
- ③ Self awareness and empathy for others flow from one's nature

Ex: Swami Vivekananda is an example of a person who was

naturally in control of his emotions.

### Emotional Intelligence - Nurtured

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- (1) Emotional Intelligence like other traits can be inculcated in oneself by training of mind.
- (2) virtues like social awareness are cultivated over time the Ghandhi went around the country to understand people
- (3) Through yoga and other self-control exercises emotional stability can emerge for  
(example) : Buddha's calmness cultivated through long tapas.

Thus it can be said that while nature may provide a good starting point, emotional intelligence in the long run depends on nurturing.

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public servants are guided by values such as compassion, objectivity, rule of law etc. However, there are various instances of value conflict where one has to be prioritized over other based on public interest.

(1) objectivity versus compassion - Evicting hawkers from the public land becomes necessary from the point of view of objectivity because it serves large public interest. However compassion may demand a lenient treatment.

(2) compassion vs. rule of law: while child labor is illegal, sometimes

it becomes inevitable in situations like lack of any earning family member thus value conflict arises.

- ③ value Conflict mostly emerge due to the need to balance the individual case versus the collective overall welfare.

Sometimes value Conflict may cause crisis of Conscience for example in Jharkhand, 14 year old girl was denied ration due to lack of ration card, she died of hunger.

while the officer followed the rule, he could not balance it with compassion thus grave tragedy happened

thus need to ensure balance by use of judgement is there

 Mandela, should be pursued  
 as a matter of Justice, as  
 an entitlement of poor and  
 not as a philanthropic  
effort of the Society.

It entails a duty to ensure basic needs of all. Deprivation of some and abundance with others is rejection or faulty redistribution process which needs to be mitigated.

Following this approach Indian government's efforts such as ensuring Right to food through national food security act can be seen as an effort of distributive justice.

This view ensures dignity of poor while ensuring them basic services as a matter of right.
