A mind all logic is like a knife all
blade, it makes the hand bleed
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One day a man woke up to
the horror of reading his obituary
in the morning newspaper. The
newspaper had reported his death by
mistake. It read, "The dynamite
king, the merchant of death is no
more."

The man went into sense
guilt on reading this. He did not
want to be known like this. He

mended his ways and used his brilliant mind to work for peace.

He was Alfred Nobel, best known for the Nobel Prize.

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The above incident lays bare the treacherous effects that too much of logic can have, for oneself and for the society at large. But using this logic constructively can have wonderful results as well.

But, what exactly is logic? What are the challenges associated with excessive logic? Is logic always bad, or does it serve a useful purpose?

Let us find out!

LOGIC: A DOUBLE EDGED SWORD

Logic refers to the ability to reason.

It means using rationality to examine things, rather than taking them at face value.

It was logic that led Newton to wonder - "Why the apple fell down?" And what transpired next is no secret. It led to discovery of gravity that forms the basis of all scientific discoveries today. Such is the magnificence of the human mind.

But logic is like a knife all blade - a knife without the protective wooden cast. It can hurt the hand using it.

At an individual level, applying too much logic to life can kill the joy of living. It can make life into a science to be decoded, rather than an art to be enjoyed.

It's rightly said that curiosity killed the goose that gave golden eggs.

Finding meaning in everything can take away the very essence of life.

Logic without integrity can make a man a more clever devil. For instance, Harshad Mehta used his financial skills to pull a deadly scam that ultimately led to his own downfall.

On the contrary Md. Yunus used the same skill to build grameen Bank in Bangladesh - a revolution that brought millions into the financial fold the world over. Such is the dual nature of logic!

Further, we must note that truth can sometimes be concocted with the film of pseudo - logic to serve ones selfish aims.

Adolf Hitler, Osama bin Laden, and in the present times, Zakir Naik stand tall testimony to this fact. They cleverly used logic to create false notions of us vs them and did huge harm to humanity.

Having seen the dangers of excessive logic, we must also note that sometimes irrationality and being illogical can actually ~~serve~~ the purpose have beautiful results.

Religion is one such area.

Mahatma Gandhi has rightly said, "where reason comes in, religion goes away". The entire concept of Bhakti lie in surrendering oneself to the divine, to the unexplained - to the force that is larger than life.

Sometimes it is irrationality

that is needed to tide beyond the crisis. To give up what, why, how and hold logical belief in ones potential.

For instance, after WW-II, if experts were to be believed, Japan would have been wiped out of the world map. If laws of aerodynamics are followed, bumble bee can not fly, but luckily the bee does not know these laws. If stuckel experts were to be believed, India had no chance in 83 world cup, williams herdof the first woman to bag four olympics gold, would not have been in a position to walk.

Thus, sometimes going beyond logic and believing in the logical can be a gamechanger.

logic: getting out of hand

With the immense potential of human mind, we are actually turning into a demigod - like controlling rains, artificial sun, premature germination, germline editing. In this quest we are tinkering with the vitals of mother Earth.

A ~~of~~ virus, smaller than the grain of salt, put entire human progress on halt and exposed the sand castles of our logic.

Even worse, the progress of science is being used to turn space, cyberspace into new theatres of war - it showcasing how logic can threaten our own survival!

But is logic always bad? Does

it not serve a useful purpose?

Logic: The answer lying

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Socrates has well said,

"An unexamined life is not worth living".

Logic is the basis of human evolution. This power to reason has set us apart from other species and turned us into mono-spc sapiens - the "biological rarity".

Yuval Noah Harari in his book Homo Deus traces how humans are trying to double their life expectancy to 140 years through wonders of science and rationality.

Rationality is also the very tool that social reformers like Raja Ram Mohan Roy and Henry Derozio used to oppose social evils - sati, widow outcasting, domestic etc.

Even our constitution makes it a fundamental duty to harbour scientific temper.

Madhyam marg: The way ahead

The solution lies in providing a wooden casing from the knife of logic, so that it be used to cut beautiful sculptures for humanity.

This wooden protection will be provided by harbouring values of integrity, love and compassion in the use of logic.

These values will direct the light of human mind into a powerful logic laser that can cut beautiful diamonds.

On the whole, human logic is a dangerous weapon. It can lead to destruction of the self.

KEEP YOUR FACE TO THE SUNSHINE
AND YOU CANNOT SEE A SHADOW

On November 9, 1914, Edison Industries caught fire. The loss was worth two million, along with all the lifetime work of 63 year old Edison. As Edison saw his burnt work and charred dreams, he said, "There is great power in destruction, thanks to god, all our mistakes are washed away. Now we can start afresh".

Two weeks after the incident, he filed for one of his greatest inventions - the first phonograph.

The verdict is clear - no failure is final if one can see the sunshine and ignore the shadow that life casts.

But what do sunshine and shadow signify in life? How to turn our face to the sunshine? What about the ~~rainy~~ cloudy days when there is no sunshine?

Let us find out!

[sunshine and shadow in life]

Sunshine is the source of life. It is the basis of Earth's survival, the ultimate, unending source of energy.

In human life, sunshine signifies hope, positivity and courage. It includes a blissful reminder of our past achievements and a strong belief in the opportunities of the future.

But, when physical barriers obstruct the path of sunlight, it creates dark shadows and even eclipse at time.

In our life too, the barriers of failure, disease and fear can create dark shadows. These barriers can be both - internal and external.

Internal barriers include our own apprehensions and fragility, while external ones are those induced by society.

No matter what the source, these dark shadows bring gloomy, despair and disdain. They can engulf

the happiness in life.

In such moments of darkness, if one has the courage to turn her head towards sunshine, miracles can happen.

One such personality, who had the power to steer through pain, to see the glass half full, is Sandeep Singh. The gunshot survivor not just dared to return to the hockey field, but captained his team and became an Azjan Awardee.

Once a blind man asked Vivekananda, "Is there anything worse than losing your sight?" He replied, "Yes, losing your vision". Thus, even on the cloudy dark days, one must see the silver lining of sunshine.

To prove this, we need not go far away. The 4th President - Abraham Lincoln -

He lost 8 elections, failed at business and even suffered a nervous breakdown. But he proved that when everything seems to end, life still remains.

In fact, it's not the moments of comfort and convenience, but times of crisis that define a man's strength.

William Shakespeare has well said that, "laughing faces do not mean there's no sorrow. But they show the courage to deal with the sorrow. For if you can't see the brighter side of life, then polish the dark side on it sins".

Matt Disney stands tall testimony to this. His work Laugh-O-Grams went bankrupt. He had hit bottom when finally Mickey Mouse gave him a break through. His movie Snow White became the first animated film to win Oscar.

He remarked, "If you believe in something, believe in it all throughout, undeniably and unquestionably".

Indian Democracy is probably the greatest illustration of seeing sunshine in moments of darkness. When political scientists predicted the "great Indian experiment" - holding elections in a country of snake charmers - will fail. But we proved them all wrong. Our democracy survived even the shadow of emergency and is flourishing till date!

Having seen the power of optimism to see the sunlight, we must also note what obstructs us in this process.

The dark clouds

As per psychologist Noah Shoag, human mind has a negativity bias. We naturally gravitate towards the negative side of a situation, which can hinder us in seeing the sunshine.

Further, the society can at times condemn some of us to life of darkness. The untouchables, outlaws and transgenders being a case in point.

In such moments, recognising the inner light within oneself can guide us through the darkness.

We can learn from Jyotiba Phule - when men threw rotten eggs on her as she went to school, she said,

"These stones and eggs are

like flowers to me. They motivate
me to work even harder'.
