1. (a) Examine how role models influence ethical behaviour. What actions can leaders take to integrate ethical conduct in their organisations? 10

Role models plays an important role in developing values, morals and ethics in an individual as they agents of socializations.

Role of Role models

- Their life story becomes source of inspiration eg Mahatma Gandhi & his book My experiments with truth is an inspiration
- Their action becomes ideal doings and this help in guiding our behaviour eg Sachin Tendulkar going out of the stadium instead of even declared "not out" by umpire. This behaviour help us in taking decisions during ethical delimas.
- They appeal to the social morals & ethics and has a wide emotional appeals eg Amitabh Bachan advocating for "closed doors" in Swatch Bharat Abhiyaan.

However, Role model should not be copied in each & every action. One should be wise enough to inculcate good values only. Copying heroism, accent comes under worshipping of respective models and not under following role models.

Leaders have to ensure ethical behaviour in the organisations - This is best for the economic growth of the company.

Ways to do so

- a) Leader should himself be the role model for others. He should abstain from coming late, or taking unethical decision. He should be open minded, objective and transparent in his working.
- b) Strict vigilance and punishment for unethical action can change people's behaviour.
- c) Code of ethics and conduct for employees to guide them during ethical dilemmas.
- d) Grievance Redressal Mechanism so that people can complaint against unethical action.
- e) Company should judiciously follow corporate governance principle and contribute towards CSR in order to inspire employees to do the same.

1. (b) According to Aristotle, for persuasion, not only Ethos (credibility of the speaker) and Logos (logical argument) but Pathos (emotional connection to the audience) is equally important. Comment. 10



Persuasion is a quality which is widely appreciated and it is essential for a civil servant to be able to persuade others.

It consists of 3 parts:

a) Ethos → Speaker's credibility is a big issue. For eg if an economic advice is given by a Bollywood celebrity, there are less chances of it being accepted in society. However if the same advice is being given by an economist like Rajeev Ram Rajar, it would be widely accepted.

But this in the long term, does not work as people usually tends to forget the source but remember the message. If message is true and logical, it will continue with the receiver.



(b) Logos - An argument should be clear, short & attractive. It should have scientific base & objectivity so that the receiver might not feel deceived after gaining knowledge about the issue from some other source.

However, logical argument should not conflict with emotions and customs of the group. For example if officials persuade for Swachh Bharat Abhiyan by giving arguments like ~~there is~~ cleanliness is also equal to worshipping God, they may not get persuaded due to conflict with emotions connected to idol worship.

(c) Pathos → It is very essential as receiver must trust the person for ~~an~~ persuasion. That's why it is essential to show a person wearing white coat and stethoscope in an advertisement of a toothpaste. Local leaders are always encouraged to persuade for the same reason.

Prospective of the ethos, pathos, logos the most important force of persuasion is correct message and correct way to persuade.

2. (a) With appropriate examples, discuss various ethical challenges associated with the utilization of public funds in India. Suggest strategies to effectively deal with these challenges. 10

Public fund refers to the fund which is collected after revenue collection or by earning profits by the government. There are always ethical issues related with the utilization.

a) Developmental v/s Environmentalism

Today in the era of climate change, government always faces dilemma of putting funds in development activities or in environment conservation activities like renewable energy, afforestation.

b) Who is more vulnerable?

Since there is always paucity of resources, therefore there is ethical dilemma to divert more fund to which scheme eg PDS or MNREGA

c) Security, international commitments

Government has to divert funds for international sources as well to help distress countries. eg

Nepal earthquake - Operation Maitri. This often leads to diversion of funds. Moreover, government has to chunk a major part of funds in defence of country (10%) which can be used for socialistic activities

Strategiesa) Outcome based budgeting

Government should see the impact of funds in various fields as per outcome based budgeting norms. This will help in better utilization of funds.

b) Improving the budget utilization

- Reducing corruption to minimise leakages
- Social Auditing
- More transparent in utilization of funds
eg RUSA → Rashtriya Vastu Siksha Yojna
utilizes "fund tracker"

c) Impact of budget through Citizen Reportcard
like one conducted by "Jan Aagrah" Nijo
in Bangalore.

A comprehensive, systematic approach is required for better utilization of funds properly.

2. (b) With proliferation of social media, people have got the opportunity to express their views anonymously and more freely. (a) What according to you, is its effect on the social and political culture of the country? (b) Discuss the role of social media in changing one's attitude, particularly the youth. 10

With the recent trend of expressing view anonymously and more freely, people have become more free in exercising their expression. This has lead to unfold of various corruptions scandals, protest & complaints against powerful voices & people

However, this has done more harm than benefits

- a) Cyber bullying → People use "anonymous" tag and release private pictures of celebrities, business men etc
- b) Rumours & communal violence → People use social media to spread unnecessary violence eg ~~Muzza~~ Muzzafer nager Riots.
- c) Trolling → People are trolling celebrities and students like Sachin Singh. They are using this platform to lower the dignity of women & vulnerable groups.

Politically, it is dividing the world even more by spreading fake news of conflicts, wars.

Internal politics is getting new shape by political campaigns online.

Anonymous comments on the political decisions creates social unrest.

(b) Social Media has changed our attitude from collectivism to individualism. Youth has become addicted to it. They have now positive attitude towards materialism & consumerism and communism. This is shown by never ending updates. Their attitude towards Indian festivals, gender, religion is getting changed. They are becoming more global citizens now. Their thoughts, value system are becoming more universal. Therefore, change in attitude by social media is both sweet & sour.

3. (a) What are the various components of an organization's work culture?
What are key issues that need to be addressed in any organisation to
create a more developmental and performance oriented culture? 10

Our constitution provides us fundamental rights, however these comes with the reasonable restrictions. They help us in telling that what a person has a right to do and what the right they to do.

1) We have right to express but it is not right to express thoughts, beliefs and facts that are irrational, wrong or immorally correct.

for example - Advertisement - they have right to sell but Right they to do is give the customer right information

2) Means v/s ends

Right they to do is adopting the correct means while achieving our goals. eg -

We have right to achieve free education but is it right to achieve it by bribing officials.

3) Law v/s eternal conscience

Law are not concrete and comprehensive, therefore

it is often conscience that guides us.

for example - Standing in queue ahead of an old lady. It is ~~not~~ ^{my} right to get things first but the right thing to do is offering her first.

Conflict gets resolved by applying morals, ethics and value system in place. If someone wants to protest against injustice, then definitely one should follow what is guided by one's conscience and his means should be also true as his ends.

eg If I want to protest against corruption, I should not use any ~~wrong~~ incorrect method in the due course. This is gross violation of my value system.

4. (a) It is vain to talk of the interest of the community, without understanding what is the interest of the individual. Discuss the statement in the present context. 10

Political ethics comprise of justice, equity, equality, transparency, accountability & responsibility. etc.

Vision, intentions, processes adopted by the political parties all should be guided by a value system.

Vision and intentions are the first key of political ethics. They should be noble and non-discriminatory eg

Demonetization with the vision of cleaning black money or land reforms for equitable justice. However, they should be the lone pillars.

Transparency & Accountability in the process of implementation is equally important to ensure complete justice.

for example - during demonetization, in spite of the good intentions, lack of accountability & responsibility of financial institutions leads to corruption and loss to the exchequer. It defeated the entire process of demonetization.

Tools used for the implementation should be fair, justiciable and accessible by all.

for example to weed out corruption, if all the forms issued for examination is available only on internet, it would be gross injustice to the students from rural background.

Established systems should be corruption free and have strong ethical framework in place to avoid wrong decision making.

eg established system in education sector fails to deter teachers who teaches tuitions in private capacity and hence destroys the scarcity of the service.

Each & every step of governance should be guided by value system.

5. (a) Swami Vivekanand brought religion to the centre-stage and gave a new meaning to it while stressing the need for harmony among faiths. In this context, discuss the relevance of his teachings in contemporary society. 10

Equating worshipping god to ~~the~~ service of masses is of significance in the present world which is full of lack of ethical standards. Values like kindness, compassion & love.

Relevance

In stopping communal violence - If we adopt his beliefs and teachings, riots will become a tale of the past.

Eradicating Poverty - Poverty is the manifestation of greed of human beings as Gandhiji said "there is enough for one's need but ~~to~~ not for one's greed". By adopting Swami's notion of brotherhood, mankind, one can help in equitable distribution of resources.

Scams, exploitation of poor will become history.

Physical Strength of Youth

Youth is often engaged in online games, addiction to alcohol, abuse etc. Therefore, it is essential to give youth back its vitality. Swamiji once said "One gets nearer to God in football field". His teachings can again help the youth of country to ~~re~~ reenergise and volunteer for the national building.

His teachings would be always a guideline for the generation to come as he himself said "Thought travel far and a man is what he thinks"

b) Challenges in Public Service Delivery

Policy level & decision making

Policies are discussed widely but only till the level of vision ~~is~~ and missions. No effort is taken in implementing them better at the grassroots levels.

Traditional Bureaucratic system filled with red-tapism, corruption. It is difficult to weed out corruption from the system.

Lack of resources and excess demand creates room for disservice and hence ~~leads to~~ nepotism, favouritism.

Lack of Public Participation & transparency → Secrecy is maintained. Funds are not allocated properly.

Inclusion and exclusion errors → ghost beneficiaries and faulty riders are present.

Lack of information and knowledge in the people which leads to their exploitation.

6. Is Emotional Intelligence influenced by cultural moorings? How would you differentiate the applicability of Emotional Intelligence in Indian society from that of Western society? 10

Emotional intelligence is ability of understanding my and other's emotions and use them wisely in decision making eg → Solomon's Judgment to decide mother of a child.

Emotional Intelligence does get influenced by cultural moorings as emotions arise out of cultures eg Idol worship and emotion associated with it is identified by an Indian Society but not by western.

However, several emotions like love, hatred are prevalent in every society, therefore do not have much implications.

Applicability of emotional intelligence in India & western society

- a) Policy Making → Indian society requires for eg eradication of patriarchy mindset from the society. Therefore one need to frame policies and schemes like Beti Bachao Beti Padhao or Sukanya Samridhi scheme.

In which ~~we~~ ~~government~~ governments try to remove the notion of girl being a burden and ~~not~~ encourage her birth. but in ~~western~~ Western ~~Social~~ Societies, Politics would be encouraged like equity & equality.

(ii) Principles of Nation

India is secular country but biased towards positive secularism which aims at encouraging and safeguarding every religion but while in western country like France, they are against the wearing of any symbol of religion in public. Policy Makers and Constitution makers have applied their emotional intelligence in understanding the emotional connect of people with the religion and how religion is a way of life. ~~They~~

(iii) Other issues like division of country into states, laws related to marriages, divorce etc are based on applicability of emotional intelligence.

7. Evaluate the success of RTI in bringing governance reforms in the country. Examine whether it has served the purpose it was meant for. 10

- b) Accountability and Responsibility in government increases.
- c) Proactive steps like status of Application or track your post have been adopted by various departments.
- d) People feel empowered and this can be shown by number in increase of application.

However,

- a) In the due course since ~~it~~ it has come into force, more than 40 activists have been killed.
- b) It is used as an "blackmail" object by the people.
- c) It has increased the burden on government employees.
- d) Increasing rates of Application at ~~Public~~ Information office ~~as will as~~ ~~Center~~ Information Commission is showing that inadequate information is not provided.
- e) NGOs and ~~public~~ political parties out of RTI
- f) low rate of justice being provided at CICs is also defeating the purpose.

RTI is still a potential tool for bringing in transparency but as recommended by 2nd AR, Negos should be brought under the RTI. Similarly CIC in Satish chandra case stated about urgency to bring in political parties under RTI

Black Money is a big menace in India and it starts with the election as shown in figure.




Fig 1: Vicious Cycle of Black Money

Due to high money requirement in election for bribing the voters, distributory freebies, parties often depend upon industrialist and in turn they give them favourable contracts.

State funding can reduce as it will provide the money and help in breaking nexus between donors and parties, but before coming to any conclusion, it needs to be ensured that

- parties would not be able to acquire money from any source
- the state funding would be transparent and unbiased

Since it is very difficult to ensure that state funding will stop inclusion of unaccountable wealth in politics therefore, it is better to ensure clean, transparent ~~methods~~ methods in today's scenario by following below:

- Bringing Political Parties under RTI
(~~the~~ Satish Chand ~~case~~ Case, (1C))
- Making it mandatory and punishable if parties do not file ~~the~~ Income tax Returns.

9. You are the officer in charge of development planning of a state whose capital is the technology hub of the country. However, the capital city is overcrowded and marred by traffic congestion. A group of top MNCs have approached you and showed their interest in expanding their operations in the capital provided that the highway connecting the SEZ to airport is widened. This has been cited as an important business requirement. The expansion of MNC operations is expected to create numerous jobs and would bring in huge revenues to the State. At the same time, the road connectivity in rest of the state, especially the rural areas, is abysmal and is in need of urgent attention. Media has been highlighting the incidents of deaths due to delay in hospitalization and other such issues which can be directly attributed to poor condition of roads. As the officer in charge of the development planning you find that the road widening project will entail huge cost and would severely curtail the rural road development programme currently being undertaken by the state. 20

(a) What challenges do you face as the officer in charge, in this situation?

(b) State your priorities and discuss how you plan to achieve them in the context of given challenges.

Officer has dilemma of using funds in either of the projects → rural road development or Widening of highway.

Both are of equal importance for country, one guarantees economic growth while other assures rural development and saving life of many.

Challenges

a) To decide what is more urgent from both the given options.

Therefore, I will take rural road development as my first priority. as

- a) Rural people have no other alternative while industries / MNCs have.
- b) Rural people are more vulnerable due to unavailability of roads while MNCs can afford flexible timings to avoid congestion.
- c) A civil servant should be objective but has empathy & compassion as one of his value. Therefore saving life of rural people and their equitable growth is very important.

My Plan

- 1) ~~I will divert the funds~~ I will first consult my team about the decision on this issue
- 2) I will ask from the ministry of Road & Highway Development for more funds

- 3) I can even ask ~~Ministry~~ Ministry of Corporate Affairs to divert fund for highway widening.
- 4) If I manage to get extra funds, then I will divide them judiciously.

a) Information dissemination to public

Intelligence Bureau reports about the ammunition should be broadcasted and spread.

This will bring a change in behaviour.

He has worked with an oil company's local affiliate for several years, and has established a strong, trustworthy relationship with Suresh, manager of the local facility. Suresh has recently recommended Ramesh to be recruited as the corporate consulting engineer for the company, which would be a position of greater responsibility along with a stable income. During a casual conversation, Suresh mentions an incident in the 1960s wherein 10,000 gallons of a petrochemical was leaked into the local environment by the company due to negligence, though at the time no damage was found, and no mention of this leak was made to the press. When Ramesh mentions that the state law requires him to report all spills, Suresh reminds him that no harm had been done and reminds him that the company can't have a consulting engineer who does not value loyalty and respect confidentiality.

Ramesh is a hardworking person as well sole bread winner. He seems to express dissent when ~~the~~ Swasth did not report the spill. This shows that he is a law abiding person.

Therefore now it is very difficult for him to accept his personal needs and of his family and at the same time, to act as a good citizen.

b) Lack of corporate governance

Oil spills must have generated the environmental effects. But this seems that due to lack of ethical standards and moral framework, Company did not report the spill.

c) Hiding defiance of law by values like loyalty & respect.

Defiance of law is a crime and it can't be overshadowed by mere vested interest of profits and brand image of a company.

(b) Option Available

i) Forget the incident & join as Consulting Engineer

Merit: Able to gain professional success which is better for him & his family

Demerit: A company like this may force even him to do illegal work and this will create a sense of guilt in his mind. Moreover, these actions are not good for society as a whole.

(ii) Ask the seniors and complaint about Suresh and misdeeds.

Merit: Suresh would be punished for his wrong doings
He will enjoy position of credibility.

Demand: Maybe the company also rejects the claim and ask you to remain silent.

(c) My Course of Action

Investigate about the spill from the company's inventory.

Ask Suresh about not to repeat it again and enquiring him whether he needs to also follow the same protocol.

If he does not give satisfactory reply, I will inform superiors about the misdeeds.

If they also neglect my request, I will approach media, NGOs and the state to complain about the spill.

I would adopt this action because

- (i) I should not worry about my job as I would be getting another ~~new~~ one as I am hardworking and definitely get another one.
- (ii) It is essential to report such issues so that further incidents can't go unnoticed.
- (iii) Guilt is very difficult to fight. One can resist being unsuccessful but not being guilty.
- (iv) The health hazards of such oil spill takes a long time to display their effects. and As a good citizen, it is my duty to save my fellow beings and environment from vested interest of such companies.

(a) Highlight the options available to you in this scenario and evaluate each of them. What course of action will you take and why?



Therefore IED should invest in the technology and manpower to create a innovative way of tackling the ones who misuses the platform.

My course of Action

I can't leave him on his own as it is against the value of love, compassion & empathy which one wishes on a friend. Moreover I should remove his misbelief of his parents about the mental health as a good citizen. As a civil servant in future, I have to develop a sense of persuasion. If I leave him alone now, it is the defeat of my whole aim of becoming civil servant.

My course of Action

I will first take the evidences cited by medical reports or a doctor's prescription to his parents to show them there exists problems like mental depressions.

If they donot agree , I will ask various
Neyos to help ~~him~~^{me} in making them understand.

I will persuade my friend to talk openly
with his parents. I will take help of videos
to show them the effect of depression on one's life.

If they donot agree, I will request them to
come to doctor with their ~~son~~. Doctor can be
a better persuader than me.

I will ask my friend to stay with me and not
follow his parents, as the last resort. This will
ensure him and me about his health as he can
take counselling sessions in the city rather than in the
rural background.

Long term Measures

I will ask government authorities like ~~the~~
Ministry of health to start awareness campaign
in the villages about mental health care.

I will write to Neyos working in this field to
spread awareness.

publicizing that it is nothing wrong to have

My Course of Actions & Reasons

I am his friend, therefore it is my responsibility to be with him during ups and downs. (HIV) से ग्रस्त हैं। उन्हें HIV का संक्रमण एक चिकित्सा पेशेवर के गलत अभ्यास के कारण हो गया था, जिसने एक संक्रमित सुई का पुनः उपयोग किया जिससे सुश्री 'X' को यह रोग लग गया। सहिष्णुता के संबंध में कंपनी की नीतियां कठोर हैं और आप सुनिश्चित करते हैं कि सुश्री 'X' किसी प्रकार के भेदभाव का सामना किए बिना कंपनी में अपना जॉब करती रह सकती है। HIV से संबंधित जानकारी प्रकट करने के कुछ दिनों के बाद सुश्री X क्रोधपूर्वक अपना त्यागपत्र जमा करती हैं। वह कहती हैं कि HIV से संबंधित जानकारी प्रकट करने के बाद उन्हें कार्यस्थल पर प्रतिदिन भेदभाव का सामना करना पड़ा है। उनके सहकर्मी उनके साथ भोजन करने में संकोच अनुभव करते हैं, वे यह

सुनिश्चित करते हैं कि जिस जलपात्र से वह पानी पीती है उसके वे पानी न पिएँ और कार्यालय की महिलाएँ उसकी वैवाहिक स्थिति पर टीका-टिप्पणी करती रहती हैं। विभागीय चर्चाओं के दौरान उनसे अलग बैठने के लिए भी कहा जाता है। वह मानसिक उत्पीड़न के लिए कंपनी पर मुकदमा करना चाहती हैं। अगर वह यह कदम उठाती हैं, तो कंपनी की सार्वजनिक छवि को क्षति पहुँचेगी और इसकी गैर-भेदभावपूर्ण नीतियों पर प्रश्न उठेंगे। कंपनी के प्रबंध निदेशक के रूप में इस स्थिति से निपटने के लिए आपको सुझाए गए कुछ विकल्प निम्नलिखित हैं। इनमें से प्रत्येक विकल्प के गुणों और अवगुणों का मूल्यांकन कीजिए:

- आप उनका त्यागपत्र स्वीकार कर लेते हैं और उन्हें एक क्षतिपूर्ति पैकेज का सुझाव देते हैं ताकि वह कंपनी पर मुकदमा न करें।
- आप उन्हें अपना त्यागपत्र जमा नहीं करने के लिए मनाते हैं और दूसरे विभाग में उसका स्थानांतरण कर देते हैं।

This is case in which a employee is facing discrimination in spite of company's neutral status. The main problem lies with the social stigma attached to HIV and steps taken should ensure behaviour as well as attitudinal change in the people.
