### Question 6:

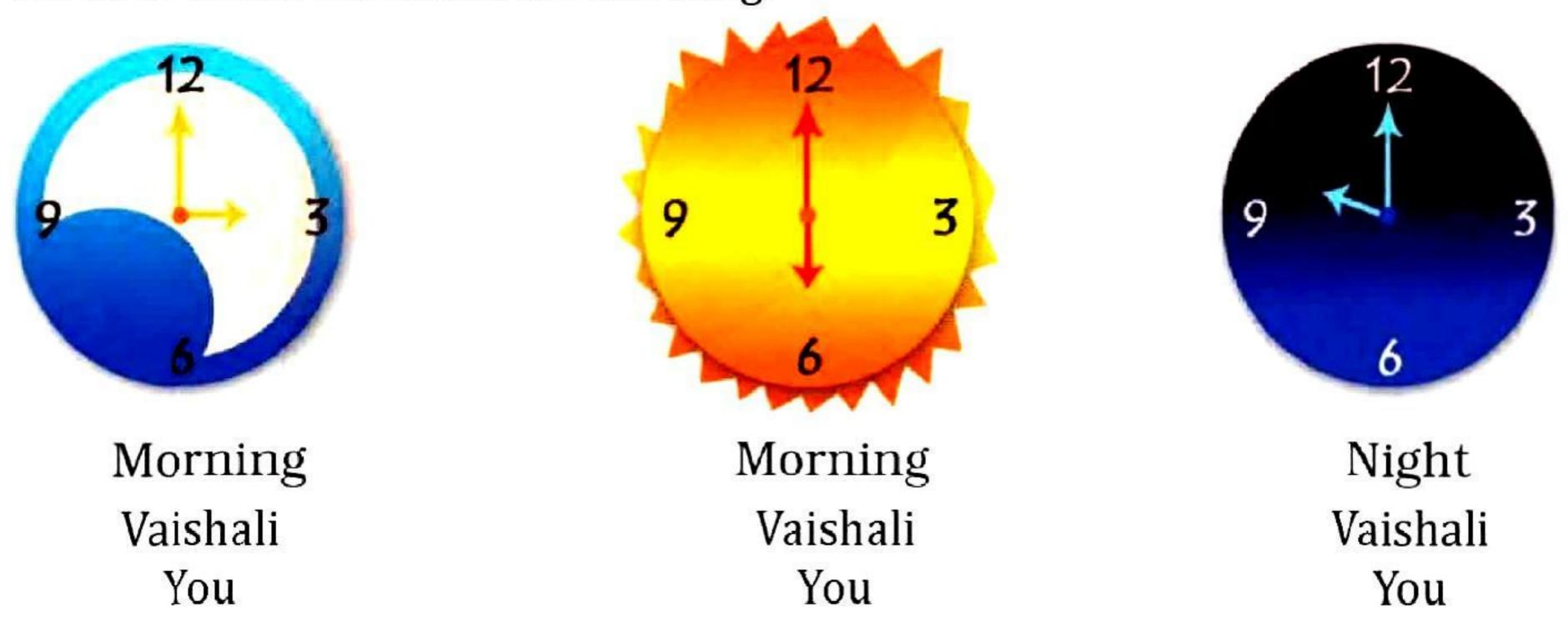
How do you help the elders in your family?

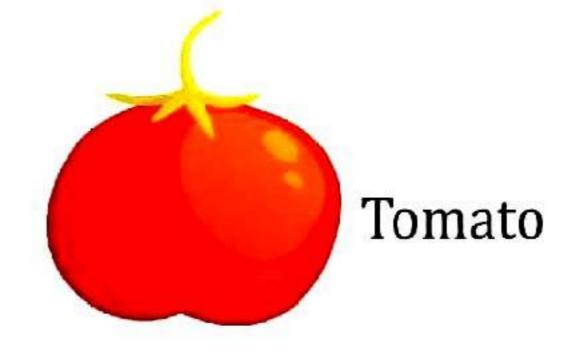
