pattern recognition receptors, and the complement system. More sophisticated mechanisms, however, developed relatively recently, with the evolution of vertebrates. The immune systems of vertebrates such as humans consist many types of proteins, cells, organs, and tissues, which interact an elaborate and dynamic network. As part of this more complex immune response, the vertebrate system adapts time to recognize particular pathogens more efficiently. The adaptation process creates immunological memories and allows even more effective protection future encounters these pathogens. This process of acquired immunity is the basis of vaccination.
