
A. Warmer

The teacher shows the national flag or its picture to the students and asks them to name the colours it has and list the occasions when we unfurl it.

Teacher: Where is the white colour, children?

Children: It is in the middle.

Teacher: What is there on the white part of the flag?

Children: There is a blue 'chakra' on it.

Teacher: You know, this is the 'Dharmchakra' of King Ashoka.

Children: Thank you, sir, for giving us important information about

our national flag.
