

# Sitting Arrangement

Sitting arrangement is a sequential arrangement of objects/persons on the basis of predefined conditions.

In this chapter, we deal with the questions based on sitting arrangement of persons or objects. In this type of questions, some conditions are given. On the basis of this, candidates are required to arrange the objects/persons, either in a row or in a circular order. While making arrangements, it should be noted that all the conditions given are complied with.

There are two types of questions, which are generally asked

### 1. Arrangement in Linear Pattern

Here, we deal with questions, where a proper arrangement is required to be done in a linear format along a straight line.

☐ When it is not given in the question that in which direction the persons are facing, then we assume them facing the North direction.

**Example 1** 5 friends are sitting on a bench. A is to the left of B but on the right of C. D is to the right of B but on the left of E. Who are at the extremes?


**Sol.** (*d*) Arrangement according to the question, the arrangement is as follows

(d) C, E

Clearly, C and E are at the extremes.

### 2. Circular Arrangement

In circular arrangement, persons/objects are arranged around a circle as shown in below figure.




Suppose A, B, C and D are four persons facing towards the centre, then their right and left sides are shown by the arrows in the above diagram. B is on the right side of A and D is on the left side of A.

**Example 2** Six persons are sitting around a circular table. Ajay is facing Hemant who is sitting to the left of Arvind and right of Sanjay. Suman is to the right of Arvind. Manoj is facing Arvind. Who is now sitting to the right of Manoj?

- (a) Arvind
- (b) Ajay
- (c) Suman
- (d) Sanjay

**Sol.** (d) Following sitting arrangement is formed from the given information,



Clearly, Sanjay is sitting to the right of Manoj.

D B A E C

So, the house in the middle is A.

PTSQR

Hence, S is the middle.

HEFDCBA

Hence, D is sitting in the middle.

Clearly, D is sitting on the right of B.

**5.** According to the question, sitting arrangement of all the five girls is as follows,



Hence, Mridula is sitting to the extreme right of the row.

Mr Ashokan


Mr Gaurav

Mr Rakesh


So, Mr Muan lives in the topmost flat.


Clearly, A and D are in front of each other in both the arrangements.
